

2022 TRC HUNTER/JUMPER SHOW

DATES: May 7, June 4, June 18, October 1

TIME: 8:30am (Jumpers not before noon)

FEES: \$10 / member class \$12 / non-member class \$5 schooling / grounds fee
Year end award nomination fee \$15 per division

Judge's decision is final. Show officials reserve the right to combine, cancel, or divide classes in the best interest of the show. Proper attire to be worn while showing, including an approved hard hat with a harness to be worn while mounted.

At each show, awards for Champion and Reserve Champion in each division.

EQUITATION DIVISION: Open to all riders of any age on horses or ponies. May cross enter, except where noted. Classes are judged on riders position, hands, seat legs, control, and appropriate use of aides. After three refusals, the rider may take a courtesy fence before exiting the arena. Riders may cross enter into other divisions, but can only accumulate points in one division for year end points. Points follow the rider and the division must be declared before the start of their first show. Points over fences will break ties.

LEADLINE: Open to all riders 7 years and younger. May not cross enter into any other division. Judged on proper seat, leg, hand position, poise and manners.

1) Leadline Walk 2) Leadline Offline Walk 3) Over fences – 2 ground poles

NOVICE EQUITATION: Open to riders of all ages in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Riders may be asked to halt, back, posting trot, sitting trot, 2 point trot, canter, and drop irons.

4) Walk/Trot 5) Walk/Tr/Ind Canter 6) Over 6 crossrails @ 12"

LOW EQUITATION: Open to all riders. May be asked to halt, back, sitting trot, posting trot, and 2 point trot.

7) Walk/Tr/Canter 8) Hunt Seat Pattern 9) Over 6 fences @ 18"

INTERMEDIATE EQUITATION: Open to all riders. May be asked to halt, back, Posting trot, sitting trot, two point trot, extended trot, and two drop irons.

10) Walk/Tr/Canter 11) Hunt Seat Pattern 12) Over 8 fences @ 2'

OPEN EQUITATION: Open to all riders. May be asked to halt, back, sitting trot, posting trot, 2 point trot, extended trot, drop irons, counter canter, and hand gallop.

13) Walk/Tr/Canter 14) Hunt Seat Pattern 15) Over 8 fences @ 2' 3"

LUNCH BREAK – SCHOOLING 30 MINUTES

Jumpers Divisions Not to Start Before Noon

JUMPER DIVISION: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Classes are judged on the least amount of faults and speed. A jumping fault is incurred when the pole, or part of the pole, is knocked to the ground. A jumping fault, refusing a fence, or circling across your path are all four point deductions. After three refusals, the rider may take a courtesy fence before exiting the arena. No time faults are given at our show. Rounds are classified according to faults. If equal faults exist, then the round winner will be determined by the time. Riders may cross enter into other divisions, but can only accumulate points in one division for year end points with the same horse. Points follow horse/rider combinations so a rider can compete for year end points with a different horse. Divisions must be declared before the start of their first show.

OPEN JUMPERS – Over 8 fences @ 3'
