## 8am-12:00pm Hunters (Flat and Over Fences)

Instructed by Sarah Welty of Rider Revelations. Keymar, MD

The Hunter session will focus on Hunter horse and rider on the flat and over fences. You will learn how a judge will be evaluating you in the show ring! This session will cover your mounts Quality and Way of going as well as the riders equitation and ability to communicate and control your mount with proper and invisible aids.
