**\$10 NOMINATION FEE FOR YEAR END** – Each team can only choose 1 division in Judged and one division in Speed for day and year end awards and that division must be ridden first or reverse penalties will be incurred. **\*\*NEW Buckle Series added!!** \$20 one time fee for nomination!

<u>JUDGED DIVISIONS</u>: Judged on performance, manners, soundness, and suitability of mount on the course. Each team will have two rides, with BOTH counting for day and year end award points.

PEE WEE – 10yrs and younger, may be penalized for assistance.

IN – HAND YOUTH W/TR {17 & younger) YOUTH OPEN (17 & younger)

GREEN HORSE W/TR – Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing trail.

NOVICE W/TR - Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing trail.

INTERMEDIATE – No trainers, professionals, or winners of any open trail event.

ADULT W/TR – No trainers, professionals, or winners of any open trail event.

ADULT OPEN – Open to any riders aged 18 and older

MASTERS W/TR - Open to any riders 55 years and older - MASTERS OPEN

<u>SPEED CHOICE DIVISIONS</u>: Each team will have 2 minutes to complete as many obstacles as possible before time runs out. A thirty second warning will be given. Obstacles can be performed twice, but not consecutively. Each obstacle will have a numeric value and the team with the most COMPLETED obstacles with the highest value will take top honors.

YOUTH W/TR YOUTH OPEN INTERMEDIATE ADULT W/TR

ADULT OPEN MASTERS W/TR MASTERS OPEN

Teams can only choose one speed division, stipulations from judged will carry over to speed. Ride ins are welcome, but new entries will close at noon. Sign up is done the Wednesday prior to each show at 5pm via text and messenger to 240-437-2222. Rules are subject to be revised by a unanimous vote by the BOD to benefit TRC. No schooling on course prior to show. Maximum time on course is 10 minutes, rider will only be scored on obstacles completed and asked to leave the arena. After 3 refusals, rider will be asked to move on to next obstacle. Horses ridden by more than one rider will carry a reverse penalty for every repeated obstacle with the second rider. Teams that have won the same division for 2yrs will be asked to move up to the next division, but the BOD can make exceptions to this rule.
